



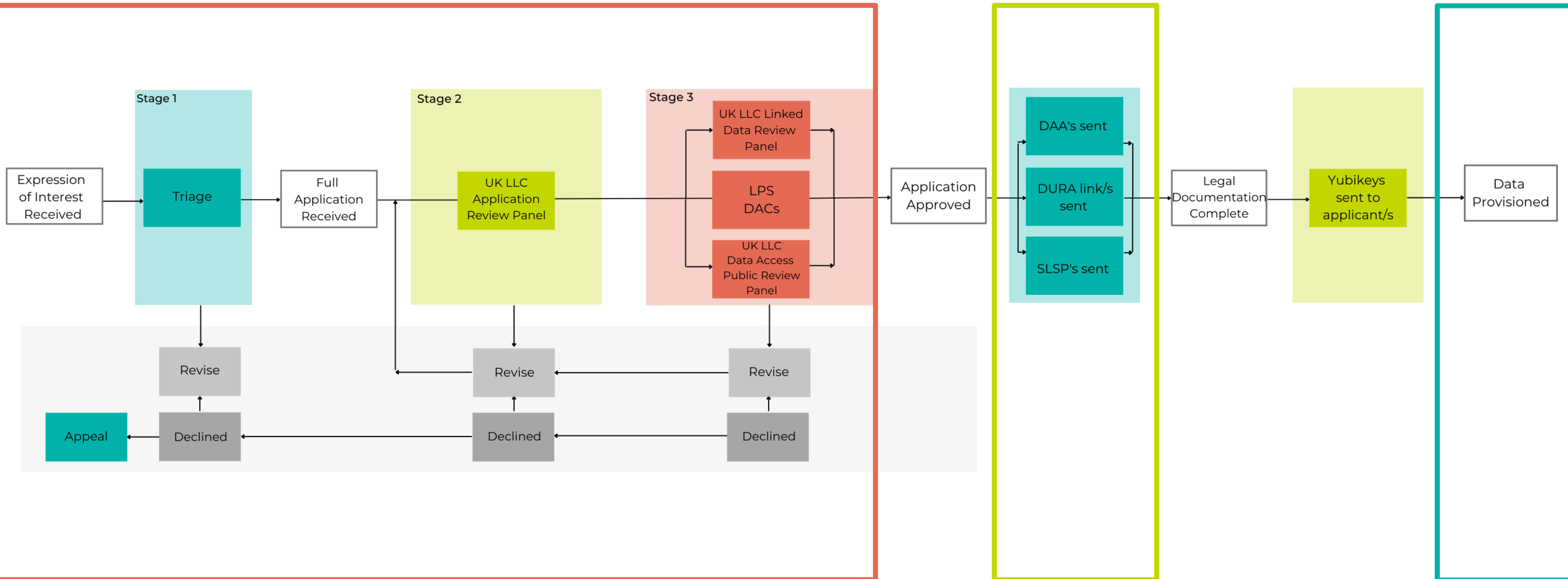

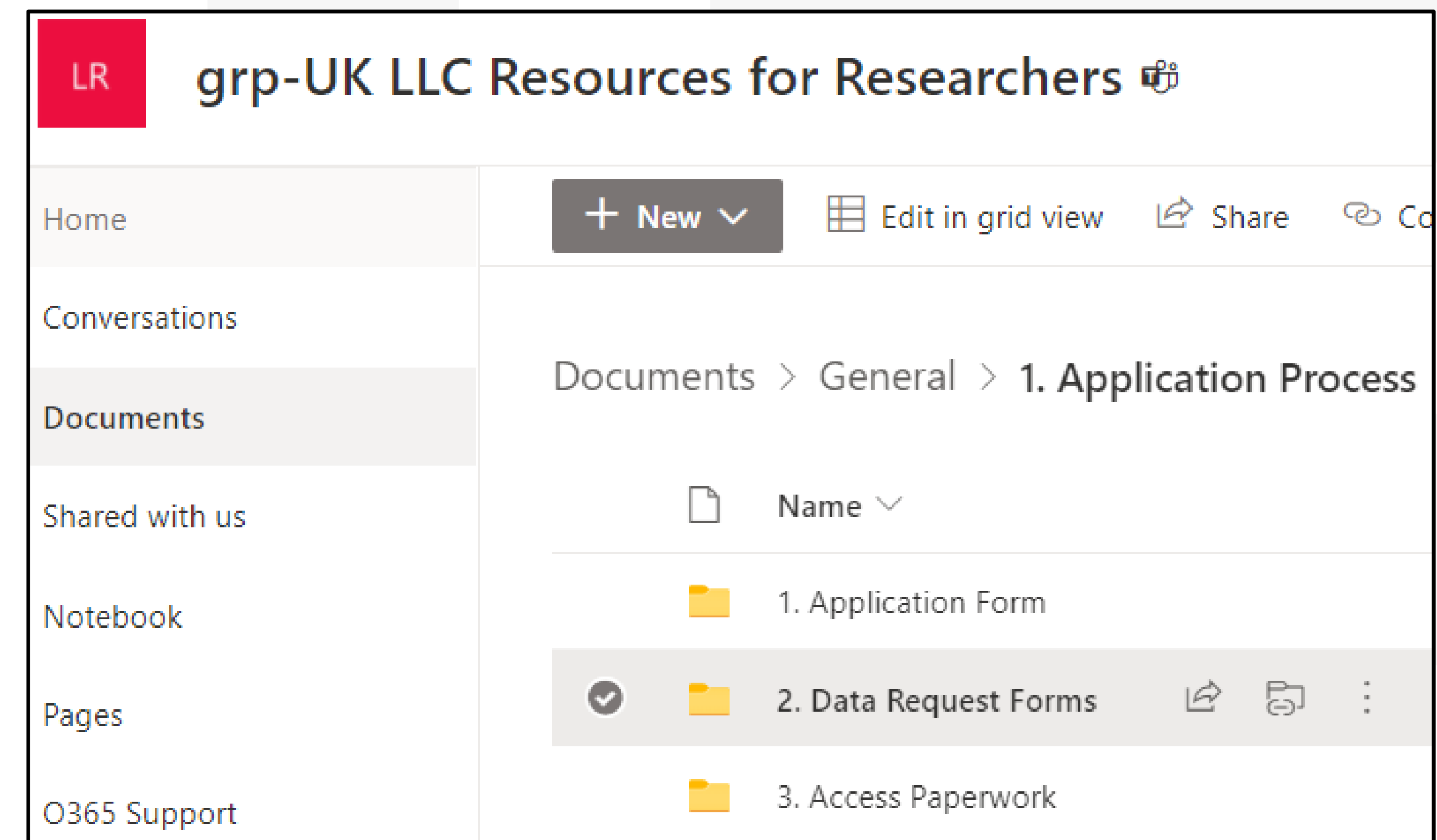

Access to the UK LLC: Data Request



- All data deposited into the UK LLC TRE is made available for request on the **Data Request Form**
- In order to make a Full Application, applicants must download and fill out a Data Request form and Codelist Template (if applicable)
- The Data Request will be reviewed as part of the Full Application Review Process, and only approved data will be provisioned in the TRE, if an application is successful
- The Data Request Form is a LIVE document, updated regularly as new data and documentation become available

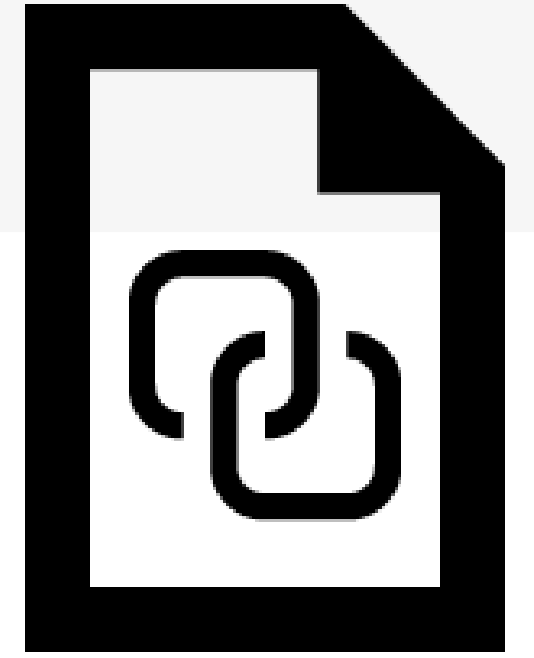
