

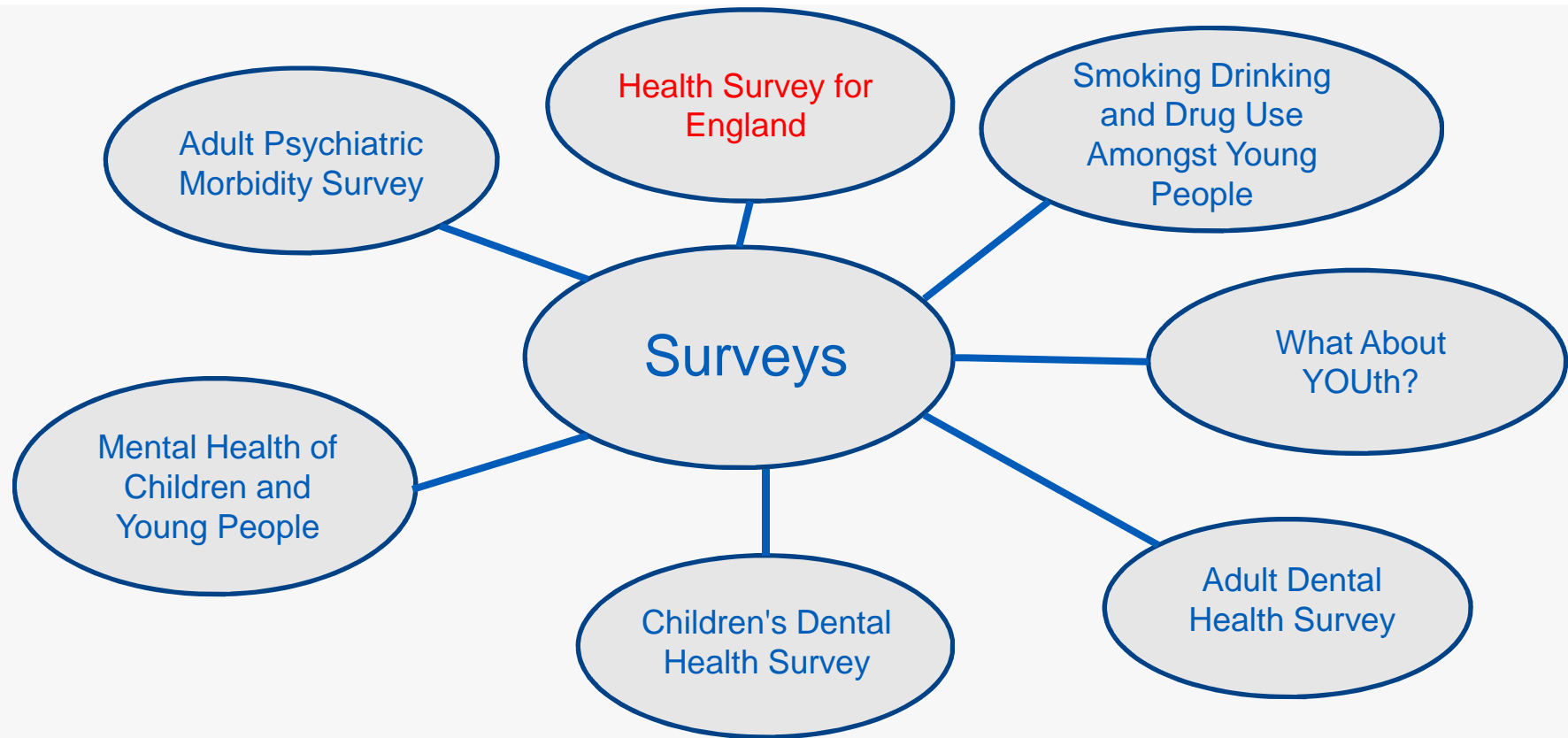

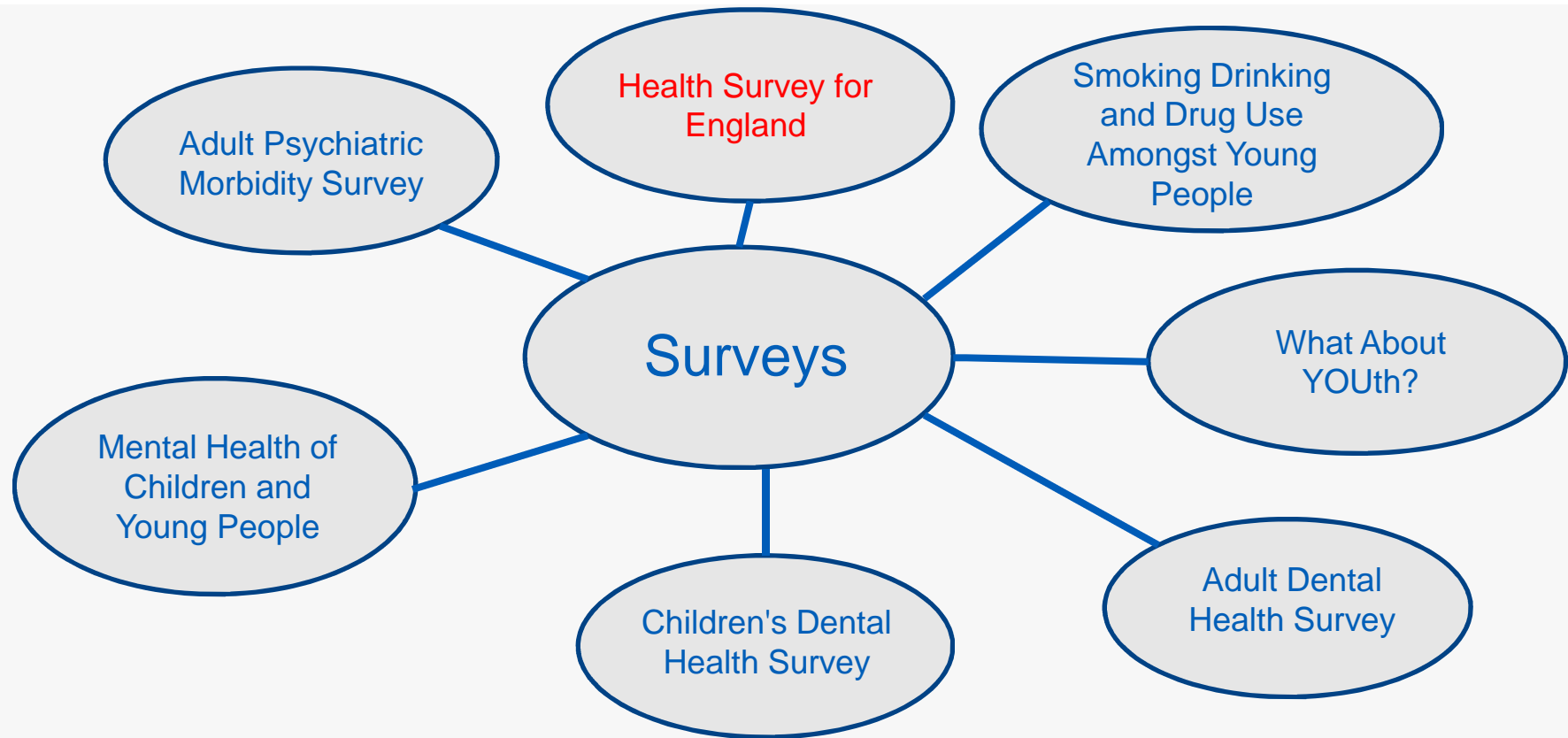

Surveys



Smoking, Drinking and Drug Use Amongst Young People

- Biennial survey, running since 1982
- School based survey
 - Pupils aged 11 to 15
 - Self-completion questionnaire under exam conditions
- Includes information on:
 - Prevalence rates, types of alcohol and drugs taken, how often, sources etc.
 - Pupils' attitudes
- Best estimates of pupils undertaking risky behaviours

Adult Psychiatric Morbidity Survey

- Mental health and well-being
- Every 7 years since 1993, last published Sept 2016
- Face to face interviews
 - Phase I: Interviews with 7,500 adults – 1 hour +
 - Phase II: Subset assessed by clinically trained interviewers
- Data on prevalence of treated and untreated psychiatric disorders, risk factors, protective factors
- Definitive source of data for population estimates of mental illness

Mental illness soars among young women in England - survey

NHS study finds 12.6% of women aged 16-24 screen positive for PTSD, 19.7% self-harm and 28.2% have mental health condition



Adult Psychiatric Morbidity Survey

- Mental health and well-being
- Every 7 years since 1993, last published Sept 2016
- Face to face interviews
 - Phase I: Interviews with 7,500 adults – 1 hour +
 - Phase II: Subset assessed by clinically trained interviewers

Dental Health Surveys

- Aim to establish the dental health of the population and how this has changed over time.

Adult Dental Health Survey

- Every 10 years since 1968, last survey 2009
- Face to face interviews with 11,500 adults
- Includes dental examination

Children's Dental Health Survey

- Every 10 years since 1973, last survey 2013
- 9,000 children aged 5,8,12 and 15 years
- Check ups with dentists at schools and questionnaire to parents/carers

What About YOUNG?

- Run in 2014
- Postal and on-line questionnaire survey of 15 year olds
- Covered general health, diet, use of free time, physical activity, smoking, drinking, emotional wellbeing, drugs and bullying
- Final sample of 120,000
- Designed to produce outputs at local authority level

Mental Health of Children and Young People

- Health, development and wellbeing of children and young people
- Last surveys in 1999 and 2004
- Data collection for 2017 survey in progress
- 9,500 children and young people aged 2-19, includes parents and teachers
- Face-to-face interviews and self completion questionnaires
- Publication planned for 2018
