#### **Consent Form D: Cancer and death records**

We have asked about your health. To make this information complete we would like to be informed **about cancer and death records** held and managed by **NHS Digital**, the national controller of health data that lists all the people in the country and their National Health Service (NHS) number. Data accessed would be the **type of cancer and/or cause of death**. If a person who took part in ELSA gets cancer or dies, the information about the type of cancer and/or cause of death will be linked with their answers to the survey.

We need your written permission for any information to be released. You do not have to give your consent for us to collect this data if you don't want to.

Data will be used by the ELSA Research Team consisting of researchers at University College London (UCL), Institute for Fiscal Studies (IFS), University of Manchester, and NatCen Social Research under restricted access arrangements which make sure that the information is used responsibly and safely.

Only NatCen Social Research, whose interviewers conduct the ELSA interviews with you, will have access to information that can be used to identify you – like name and address. Basic information about the mortality status of ELSA cohort members will be made available for other researchers. Access to the full data for other qualified researchers can only be granted by the ELSA Research Team through a separate written application process that has been approved by NHS Digital. The information will be completely confidential and will be used for research purposes only by academic or policy researchers under restricted access arrangements.

As we would like to look at long term trends in people's health, we have not set a limit on how long we would like to keep your information. ELSA has been running since 2002 and is very valuable for looking at how people's health changes over time.



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
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
