






27 March 2023

The BHM health staff managed to book her an appointment on the same day, which was great.





You have the option to either purchase or donate money to take some of the seasoned vegetables and herbs.


Silly me, I saw a little kid take an onion so I decided to do the same. Haha!

5 June 2023


Here, we got training for a day about data analyses and coding.
