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### About Positive Voices

Positive Voices is a large-scale survey of adults living with HIV and attending one of **73** NHS HIV specialist clinics in England and Wales. Results will provide valuable insights about living with HIV that will be used to inform improvements to services.

The questionnaire can be completed on a paper or on-line. It aims to recruit between 3,000 and 4,000 patients from January – September 2017. All participants receive a £5 gift voucher as a thank you.

### Notes on Study Closure

- A site is ready to close once all patients on the Study Log have been assigned a Recruitment Status (accepted, declined or non-recruitable), ie. all selected patients have been approached and asked to take part in the survey.
- Originally, sites were given six months to recruit from the date the first participant completed their questionnaire. HRA approval given approval to extend recruitment for all sites, where needed, until **30th September 2017**.
- Sites that have a Recruitment Status for all patients on the Study Log do not need to take this additional time, but sites who have not approached all the patients in the Study Log can request an extension if needed.
- The PV team will email sites two weeks before their original closure date to close the study (**see below**) or extend as required.
