

Join the Hazlitt Society

The Hazlitt Society grew out of a project to restore Hazlitt's long-neglected grave in St Anne's churchyard in Soho. The committee which was formed for the purpose of the restoration established the society to encourage appreciation of Hazlitt's work and values. The society depends on the generosity of its members to pursue these goals through its activity. Since 2005 the society has organized a free annual lecture by a public intellectual and/or scholar of Hazlitt and Romanticism at Conway Hall, London, and latterly University College London, on the Saturday nearest 18th September, the day Hazlitt died. The society has also been involved with the Hazlitt Day Schools which have taken place at St Catherine's College, Oxford, and which now run alongside the annual lecture at UCL. These events provide an opportunity for students of Romantic literature and general readers to meet and to discuss their interest in Hazlitt. An annual newsletter alerts members of the society to the lecture, Day School, and any other events that may be of interest to Hazlittians.

The Hazlitt Review, launched in September 2008, is an annual peer-reviewed journal which aims to foster and sustain Hazlitt's standing among the latest developments in study of the Romantic era. It is distributed at the lecture or sent to members by post anywhere in the world, free of charge. Back issues of most numbers are also available *gratis* for members.
