


Research Questions





Q3: What forms of **resistance** have people from these groups developed in response to the lack of citizenship rights and access to resources? Q4: How do members of the younger generations of Pakistani Bengalis understand the migration history and subsequent lives of their parents and grandparents, and how do they relate this to their own lived experiences in Pakistan? 
