



Туре	Eligibility Criteria and Track Records	
StG	 PhD awarded between 2 and 7 years prior to 1st January 2016. Highlighting five representative publications, those without the presence as coauthor of their PhD supervisor, and the number of citations. At least one important publication without the participation of their PhD supervisor. 	
CoG	 PhD awarded between 7 and 12 years prior to 1st January 2016. Highlighting ten representative publications, those without the presence as coauthor of their PhD supervisor. Several important publications without the participation of their PhD supervisor. Being able to demonstrate a promising track record of early achievements appropriate to their research field and career stage, including significant publications etc. 	
Adv	 No specific eligibility criteria. Significant research achievements in the last 10 years. Highlight ten representative publications 10 publications as senior author.

Funding ID	No limit
Early Achievements track Record	Max 2 pages
Extended Synopsis of the Scientific Proposal	Max 5 Pages

Restrictions for submission

A Principal Investigator whose proposal was evaluated as **category A** in the Starting, Consolidator or Advanced Grant calls for proposals under Work Programme 2015 may submit a proposal to the Starting, Consolidator or Advanced Grant calls for proposals made under Work Programme 2016.

A Principal Investigator whose proposal was evaluated as **category B** at step 2 in the Starting, Consolidator or Advanced Grant calls for proposals under Work Programme 2015 may submit a proposal to the Starting, Consolidator or Advanced Grant calls for proposals made under Work Programme 2016.

A Principal Investigator whose proposal was evaluated as **category B** at step 1 in the Starting, Consolidator or Advanced Grant calls for proposals under Work Programme 2015 may <u>not</u> submit a proposal to the Starting, Consolidator or Advanced Grant calls for proposals made under Work Programme 2016.

A Principal Investigator whose proposal was evaluated as **category C** in the Starting, Consolidator or Advanced Grant calls for proposals under Work Programmes 2014 or 2015 may <u>not</u> submit a proposal to the Starting, Consolidator or Advanced Grant calls for proposals made under Work Programme 2016.

- Typically a team of about 3-4 people
- Both Post Docs and Students
- Equipment
- Consumables
- Travel
- Publications

ERC Consolidator Grant

CoG 2015

- 2051 submissions
- 620 submitted to LS domain
- 359 applications from Pls to be based at UK organisations - the highest number of applications to the call (around 17.5% of the total)



Main aims of CoGs

- **Support and consolidating the career** of excellent researchers.
- Strengthen independent and excellent new individual research teams that have been recently created.
- Provide best settings and structures to researchers to become autonomous investigators

Research funded

- Excellent innovative and investigator initiated
- Ground-breaking
- Any field
- Multi-and-interdisciplinary research proposals
- Not suitable for consortiums

UCL

CoG - Expectations from PI

- To lead their team and be fully engaged in the running of the grant
- A minimum 40% of total working time on the ERC project and
- A minimum of 50% of total working time in an EU
 Member State or Associated Country
- To chose a host institution in EU Member State or Associated Country

Host institutions

- Any type legal entity
- Must be based in the territory of an EU Member State or Associated Country
- Normally employs the PI
- Must sign a letter of commitment as part of application
- If funded signs up to the Grant Agreement and a 'Supplementary Agreement'


Team Members

- PI's host institution normally the only institution but can have team members from other institutions
- Team members can be of any age, nationality & country of residence
- Individual research team headed by a single PI so NOT a traditional network or research consortium



More on CoG

- Normally maximum grant €2 million over 5 years (pro rata)
- Can have an additional €0.75 million (not pro rata) for equipment, start up etc.
- Any additional funding requested must be justified in Part B Section 2c
- 100% costs funded and 25% indirect costs
