# London LGBTQ+ Community Centre

The London LGBTQ+ Community Centre is a sober, intersectional community centre and café where all LGBTQ+ people are welcome, supported, can build connections and can flourish.

# Project LGBTQ+

Project LGBTQ+ is an initiative launched by Hongkongers in Britain (HKB) in April 2023, aimed at providing support for LGBTQ+ Hongkongers living in the UK and promoting equality in the Hongkonger communities in the UK.

# LGBTQ+ Counselling/Psychotherapy

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We offer counselling and support around issues such as samesex relationships, sexual and gender identity and promoting personal growth and self-confidence. We're also home to Antidote - the UK's oldest LGBT drug and alcohol service. Our social groups provide a safe space to meet and socialise as an alternative to the bar and club scene.

# elop \* Elop

Elop is a holistic lesbian and gay centre that offers a range of social, emotional and support services to LGBT communities, and our core services include counselling and young people's services. We can also offer training and consultancy for fellow professionals and those seeking to enhance their understanding of issues facing LGBT communities.



### Pink Therapy

Pink Therapy offers a directory of qualified LGBTQIA+ friendly therapists and counsellors providing trusted, non-judgmental services for people who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans, queer, asexual, intersex and anyone who identifies as gender, sex or relationship diverse.



# Spectra London

We exist to support people of all sexualities, gender identities, cultural influences and ethnicities who want to make positive changes to their lives. (They offer a wide range of services including for LGBTQ+ sex workers).

# Spectra Trans Services

Spectra offers social groups, 121 support, counselling and workshops. Spectra's services are delivered by people of trans experience themselves in a friendly, safe, confidential, nonjudgemental and accessible space.



# Gendered Intelligence

Gendered Intelligence works with the trans community and all those who impact on trans lives and specialises in supporting young trans people 8-30. (They deliver mentoring, support groups and have a help line for trans\*/non-binary people).



# Mermaids

Mermaids supports transgender, non-binary and gender-diverse children and young people, as well as their families and professionals involved in their care.

# Galop

# **LGBTQ+ Housing Support**



### **Stonewall Housing**

We're the leading national charity supporting lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans and queer (LGBTQ+) people of all ages who live in the UK and are experiencing homelessness or living in an unsafe environment. Founded in 1983, we provide housing advice, mental health advocacy and support for people fleeing domestic abuse. We also have a safe accommodation scheme in London.



AKT supports LGBTQ+ young people aged 16-25 in the UK who are facing or experiencing homelessness or living in a hostile environment. We help young people stay safe in a crisis, find emergency accommodation, access specialist support and develop skills and achieve life goals.



# The Outside Project

The Outside Project is an LGBTIQ+ Community Shelter, Centre and Domestic Abuse Refuge in response to those within the LGBTIQ+ community who feel endangered, who are homeless, 'hidden' homeless and feel that they are on the outside of

services due to historical and present prejudice in society and in their homes.
