

2021/22 Student Survey: Postgraduate Taught

Participation



Compared to last year, there was a **100%** increase in student participation for the student survey.

Community



More students felt a sense of community with their department than last year, particularly for female students and students of ethnic minorities.

But **22%** of students, especially female students, did not agree. The results were worse for white females than for females from ethnic minorities.



Fairness and Respect

11% of female students did not feel treated with fairness & respect at IoN



Bullying and Harassment



More students knew how to report bullying and harassment than last year.

And while more students completed 'Active Bystander' training than last year, **only 41%** of respondents did complete it.



Only **a small majority** of students felt *able* to report bullying and harassment without fear of negative personal consequences.

1 student reported experiencing bullying, and 2 students had witnessed bullying or harassment.



Workplace Culture

11% of students felt that the workplace culture at the IoN had a negative impact on their mental health.



Mental Health



A large majority felt the IoN was making mental health a priority, when only a minority agreed to that last year.

Participation



22% of students participated, as opposed to **19%** last year.

Community



More students (**66%**) felt a sense of community with their department/lab than last year, in comparison to **60%** last year.

But **11%** of female students did not agree. The results were worse for white females than for females from ethnic minorities.



Fairness and Respect

There was a **6%** drop in female students agreeing to being treated with fairness and respect at the IoN.



Bullying and Harassment



Over **two-thirds** of students knew how to report bullying and harassment.

Nearly **80%** of students have had the Active Bystander training, with an increase in respondents with ethnic minority backgrounds.



Only **36%** of students felt able to report bullying and harassment without fear of negative personal consequences.



6 students reported experiencing bullying, and 9 students had witnessed bullying or harassment.



Workplace Culture

53% of students responded with at least one positive example of workplace culture at IoN



32% of students feel that the workplace culture had a negative impact on their mental health.

Mental Health



75% students agreed that the IoN is actively making mental health a priority

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
