Personal Statement: Leadership and Career Aspirations

Question 1: Why are you interested in leadership? Give examples of any previous leadership experience or other relevant skills or experience (150 words maximum)

Question 2: Give examples of personal strengths and weaknesses. How have you gone about addressing these? (150 words maximum)

Question 3: What are your future career aspirations? How do you anticipate a Laidlaw scholarship helping you towards these? (150 words maximum)

Question 4: Explain why you are interested in your choice of project (150 words maximum)

Question 5: What is your chosen research project trying to achieve? Why is it important? (150 words maximum)
