Inter Library Loan requests made for articles and chapters from books can be supplied electronically using British Library's new LiveCycle DRM (LCDRM) delivery method.

The email you receive with the link from the British Library will prompt you to login with your registration details.

You will also find the link to download the document via this email. The document can be viewed from anywhere on any machine, including mobile devices. Please note conditions attached to the service:

- Document should be downloaded only once within 30 days but can be stored for up to 3 years, and viewed many times
- Copyright legislation allows the document to be printed once only. We recommend you print out your document as soon as it is convenient. You must open the document on the computer where you intend to print it

Hardware Specifications

- Before submitting your first Inter-Library Loan request you must check that you can download and print e-documents. Your computer should have installed Adobe Reader 10 or above.
