At the Eastman Dental Library we participate in UCL's [Green Impact](#) initiative.

Our goal is not just to educate, but to get both staff and students involved in a variety of projects and activities. Here is a selection of ongoing campaigns and specific projects we currently support.

- We are promoting the Do Nation campaign by encouraging staff and library users to make small behaviour changes that add up to a better world. There is a wide range of manageable pledges to choose from, and you can either sign up online, or speak to one of us at the issue desk if you want to participate.
- Like in previous years we have participated in 2018's Fairtrade-Fortnight by holding the Eastman Dental Great Library Bake Off.
- We encourage recycling by providing mixed recycling bins and by displaying guides on how to use them. We offer re-usable single sided printed paper to all library users and promote double sided printing wherever possible.
- As an ongoing project we are using Warp It to find new owners for items, office equipment and materials that we are not using anymore, but that is still fully functional. This helps us to both recycle and prevent wastage.
- We promote cycling and UCL's own cycle scheme for members of staff as a healthy and environmentally friendly form of commuting.
- Making a positive long term impact on sustainability means re-thinking and challenging the way we use a variety of resources. This is why throughout the year we are raising awareness for water saving, sustainable energy use and for biodiversity.
