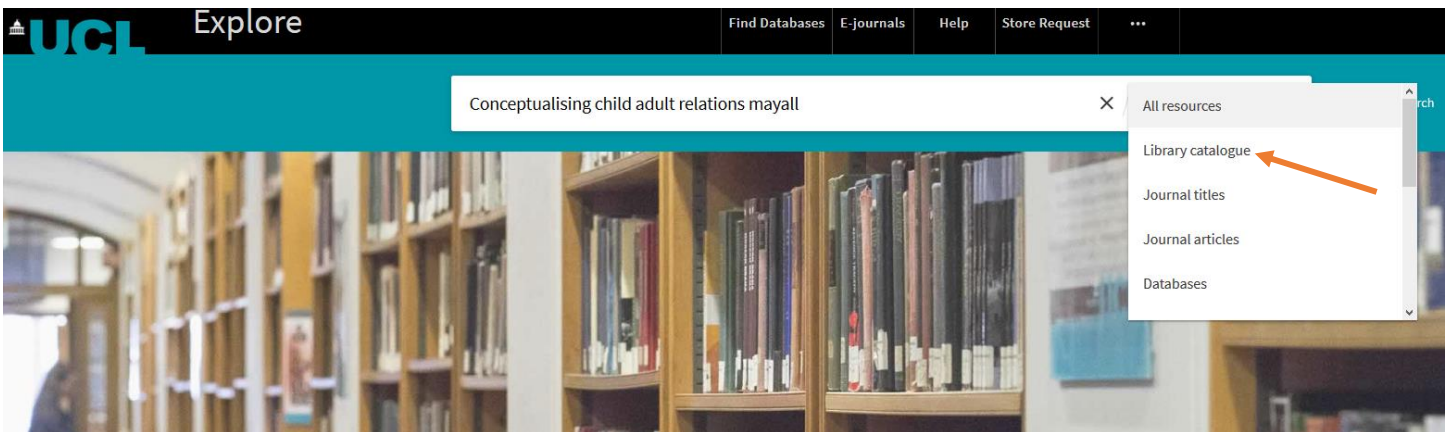
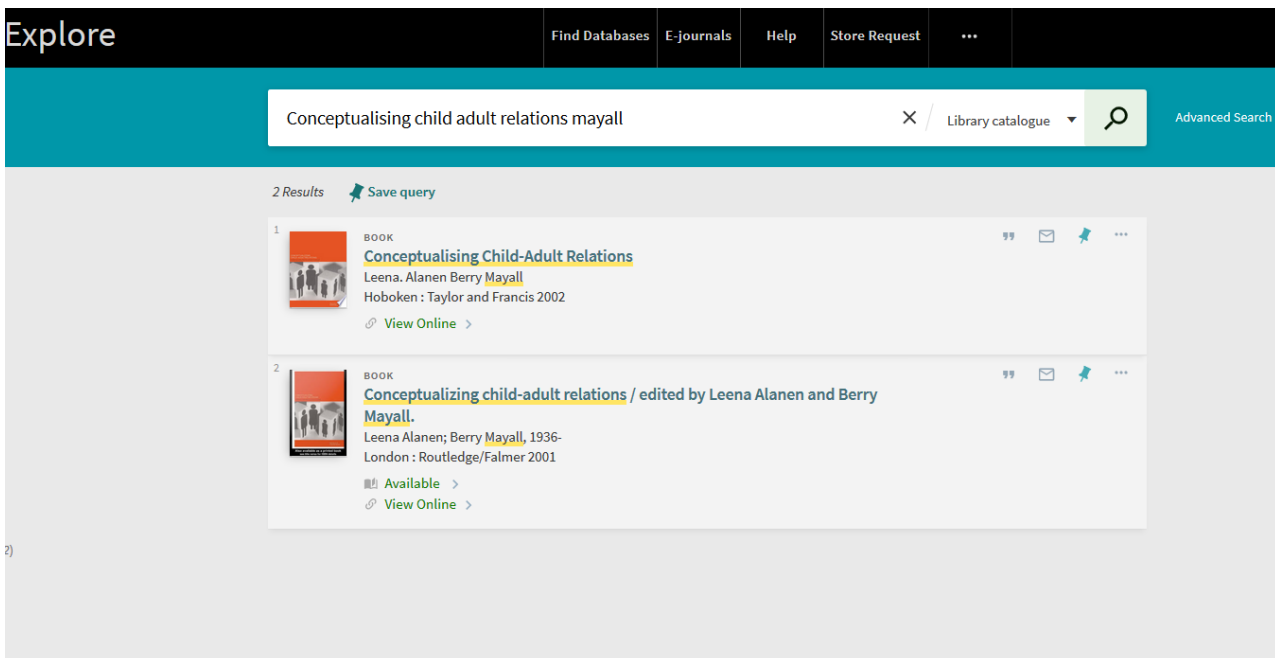


## ReadingLists@UCL: bookmarking from Explore

1. Go to the Explore home page <http://www.ucl.ac.uk/library/explore/> and sign in (top right hand corner)
2. Enter your search terms (here I used words from title and author name). Select 'Library catalogue' to limit the search. Click the search icon.



3. A list of one or more results will be returned. In this example I wish to use the second record which has paper books in the library, and also an e-book available (you can tell this from the green 'Available' for books and 'View online' for e-books). Click on the record you wish to bookmark from.



4. This following screen shows more details. From here, click on your 'Add to my bookmarks' button.
