

Newly Acquired Electronic Resources for Moorfields Staff

The library is pleased to let Moorfields staff know that we have acquired new electronic resources from ClinicalKey, Elsevier, that are accessible with an NHS OpenAthens account:

- **11 e-journals** including *American Journal of Ophthalmology, Survey of Ophthalmology, Ophthalmology, Ocular Surface, Journal of Optometry, Journal of Cataract and Refractive Surgery and Journal of AAPOS.*
- **42 e-books** including the latest edition of *Kanski's Clinical Ophthalmology, Ryan's Retina, Gass' Atlas of Macular Diseases, Krachmer Cornea Atlas, The Eye: Basic Sciences in Practice by Forrester.*
- **Other Electronic Resources** include *Guidelines, Clinical Trials, Drug Monographs, Patient Education and images.*

To access these resources follow the steps below

First you will need an NHS OpenAthens account. You can [self-register](#) if you do not have one.

1. Go to www.evidence.nhs.uk
2. Click on **Journals and Databases** tab on the top right of the screen.
3. Click on the **Log in to OpenAthens** in the middle of the page and log in. A list of available resources will be displayed.

e-Journals

- To access e-journals, click on the **e-journals A-Z list**
- Click on the **OpenAthens Login** tab on the top right of the next page. This refreshes the page and you should be able to see your username. Hello nhs....
**N.B. Unless you do this, you will not be able to see the locally subscribed content, including the new titles.*
- Within the list of journals there are various suppliers and it is not always straightforward to login to the free content. Please contact us for advice if you encounter any difficulties.

e-Books – follow steps 1-3 above

- To access ebooks from ClinicalKey, click on **ebooks: 42 Ophthalmic books**. This will take you to ClinicalKey's web page.
- Click on **Login** located at the top of the screen.
- Do not put your username and password in the space provided, instead click on the **OpenAthens Login** tab on the right hand side. This will refresh the page and log you in.
- Click on the **Books** tab. You should now be able to see the list of books that you can access.

N.B. You can download PDF files of book chapters and images from books, journals and other resources and export to PowerPoint presentations as long as you abide by the copyright rules.

The newly purchased resources make our existing collection more comprehensive. You now have access to over [70 ophthalmic e-journals](#) and more than 70 ophthalmic e-books. In addition to ophthalmic resources the NHS Evidence site covers most aspects of biomedicine disciplines including nursing, anaesthesia and management.
