

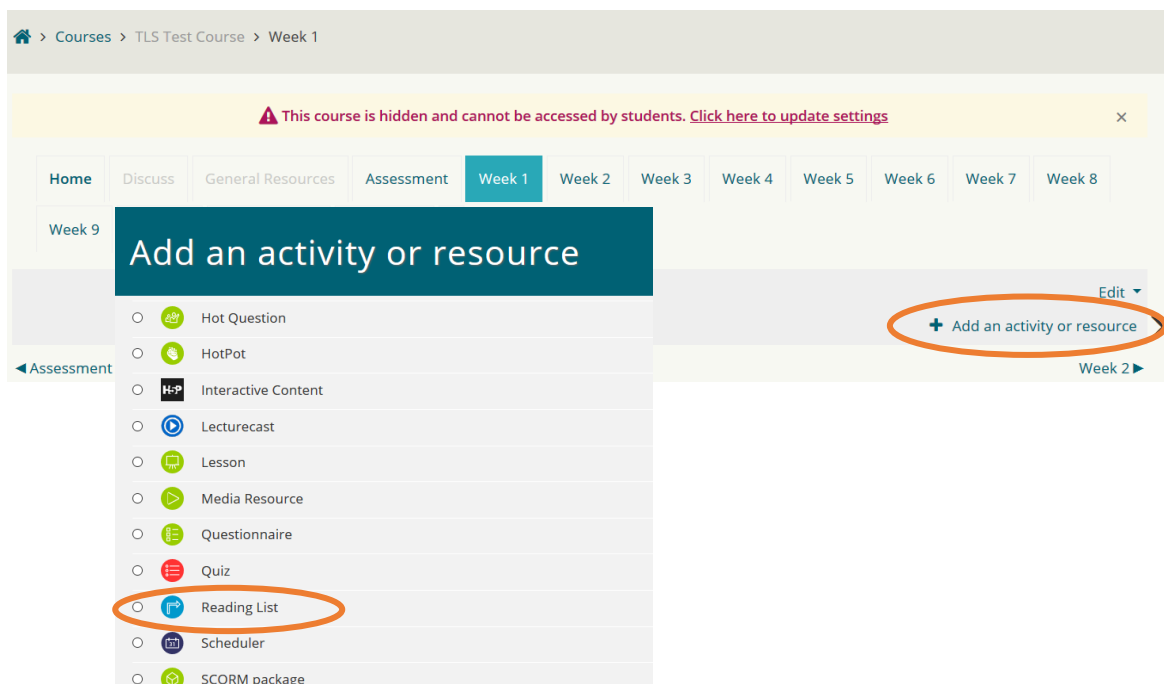
ReadingLists@UCL Moodle Integration: Embedding lists or sections

This embeds a whole reading list, or parts of a list, into a section of Moodle. It can be a helpful way to highlight essential readings or resources for a particular week. The student can access readings without leaving the Moodle page.

This activity requires annual maintenance each summer to check the resources still display, after your annual updates to the reading list and also the Moodle / ReadingLists@UCL rollovers.

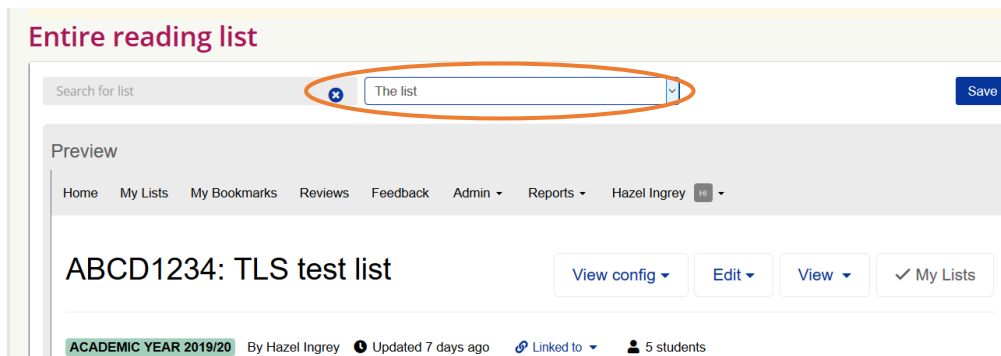
N.B. you cannot embed one individual reading, only a 'section'. Please remember to organise your list into sections when you set it up, if you wish to use this option.

1. From your Moodle course home page, select 'Turn editing on'.
2. In the relevant Week or part select 'Add an activity or resource'.
3. Scroll down to select 'Reading list' and click 'Add'.



4. Add an 'Activity name' (such as 'Reading list' or 'Week 1 readings') then 'Save and display'.
5. You will be prompted to log in (by the UCL single sign-on, using your UCL ID and password). Your list may appear automatically, or you may be asked to search for it – try using the module code. (Moodle uses its 'Course short name' to search for a match in the reading lists).

6. To display the whole list use the drop down option 'The list' and Save.



7. To instead add a section from the list, use the drop down box to choose the relevant section. Click the blue 'Save' button to display.
