

2023 OPEN ACCESS GUIDELINES FOR LM CB AUTHORS

- **Open access (OA) policy** applies to peer-reviewed research articles, conference proceedings and reviews
- All LM CB research articles, conference proceedings and reviews **MUST** be compliant with MRC open access policy, irrespective of funding (because the LM CB is MRC-funded)
- Requirement is open access, on publication, under the CC BY licence, in Europe PubMed Central, either through Gold or Green open access.
- Journals fall under three categories:

Fully open access journals – in the [Directory of Open Access Journals](#). **Gold open access.**

Journals with “transformative agreements” for UCL corresponding authors

Transformative agreements with specific publishers allow papers by UCL corresponding authors to be made **Gold open access**. Find list of publishers and details [here](#). The agreements mostly cover hybrid (subscription) journals, but include some fully open access ones.

Hybrid (subscription) journals NOT in a transformative agreement

Green open access/rights retention

- Journal must allow the accepted manuscript to be made open access on publication (no embargo) in Europe PubMed Central under the CC BY licence/authors must retain their right to this
- Authors **MUST** upload manuscript to Europe PMC on publication, with the CC BY licence and 0 embargo
- Authors **MUST** upload manuscript to RPS within 3 months of online publication

Gold open access – Immediate open access with one-off payment to unlock paywalled content

- UKRI will not fund hybrid open access outside transformative agreements

- **UCL has funding to cover open access costs** for fully open access journals and transformative agreement journals (see details in Table)
- **All LM CB research articles must include:**
 - Details of how any underlying research materials, such as data, samples or models, can be accessed
- **UKRI/Wellcome submission statement and rights retention**

The wording below **MUST** be included in the funding acknowledgements section of ALL manuscripts and in any cover letter or note accompanying submissions:

UKRI funding

‘For the purpose of open access, the author has applied a Creative Commons Attribution (CC BY) licence to any Author Accepted Manuscript version arising’.

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When you are getting a manuscript ready for publication, please check:

1. [DOAJ](#), to see whether your journal of interest is fully open access – if so, [contact UCL’s OA Team](#) for funding
2. If the corresponding author is at UCL, whether your journal of interest is in [UCL’s transformative agreements](#)

If you are publishing in a journal that is

- **NOT [fully open access](#), AND**
 - **NOT in [UCL’s transformative agreements](#) OR**
 - **the corresponding author is NOT at UCL**

PNAS	National Academy of Sciences	Rights Retention – include submission statement and discuss with OA Team before submission.
Science	AAAS	Specifically permits Rights Retention. Include submission statement and upload accepted manuscript to Europe PubMed Central and RPS.
FULLY OPEN ACCESS JOURNALS (mandatory fee for open access) (Gold)		
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Nature Communications	Nature	OA funding available
Scientific Reports	Nature	OA funding available
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
