### HARDSHIP FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE UCLMS SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES COMMITTEE

The following Scholarships and Bursaries are funded by bequests to the former Middlesex Hospital Medical School, The Royal Free School of Medicine, and UCH Medical School.

Applications are submitted through Moodle in May/June each year for consideration by a panel drawn from UCLMS Student Support Tutors and chaired by the Divisional Tutor, with a representative from the Royal Free to approve the awards drawn from Royal Free bequests.

**Year 1 students are eligible to apply for the below awards to support their studies in Year 2**

#### **BENNETT WATERS**

Awards of up to £1000 through a bequest to UCL Medical School.

#### **MARY SCHOFIELD, VERNON CHINNERY-HALDANE, ISABEL PULTENEY, FLORENCE HUGHES, DR MARGARET TODD, SIR OWEN ROBERTS, SCHOOL JUBILEE BURSARY SCHOLARSHIPS**

Awards totalling approx £1,700 through bequests to the Royal Free Hospital School of Medicine for students progressing into Year 2

**Year 2 students are eligible to apply for the below awards to support their studies in Year 3**

---

#### **GOLDBERG SCHACHMANN & FREDA BECKER MEMORIAL FUNDS (IBSc)**

Awards totalling approximately £16,000 p.a. through a fund administered by the University of London to support IBSc students and used to fund scholarships for students who are experiencing financial hardship. £100 p.a. is used to fund the Professor Jane Dacre prize for a non-laboratory based IBSc project prize.

**Year 4 students are eligible to apply for the below awards to support their studies in Year 5**

#### **ELIZABETH GARRETT ANDERSON SCHOLARSHIPS FOR WOMEN**

Awards totalling approx £25,000-£30,000 p.a. through donation to the Royal Free Hospital School of Medicine for students progressing into Year 5

Awards totalling approx £18,000 through bequests to the Royal Free Hospital School of Medicine for students progressing into Year 5

**Year 4 and 5 students are eligible to apply for the below awards to support their next year of study**

### **PETER COSTIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

5 awards each of £2,000 bestowed in 2012 by the Royal Free Charity in memory of Peter Costin to provide funds for UCL students in their final 2 years of the MBBS programme who are financially penalised by NHS bursaries failing to cover the costs of increased tuition fees

**Students entering Year 4, 5 or 6 and graduate entrants in Year 2 who are not taking an IBSc are eligible to apply for the below awards to support their next year of study**

---

### **CROXON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Awards totalling approximately £1,400 through a bequest in 1955 by Mr G.F.C. Croxon in memory of his son, Kenneth Eric Croxon, R.A.F., who was killed in action in 1943

### **DOUGLAS AND ANNE FELTHAM SCHOLARSHIP**

Awards totalling approximately £1400 through a bequest to UCH School of Medicine in 1960 by Mr Douglas Feltham.

### **FERRIERE SCHOLARSHIP**

Awards of £700 through a bequest to UCH School of Medicine in 1930.

### **PROFESSOR FRANZ HOBBIKER**

Award of £1000 through a bequest in memory of Professor F Hobbiger, Professor of Pharmacology and Clinical Pharmacology at the Middlesex Hospital Medical School.

### **DR NORMAN MUNRO SCHOLARSHIP**

Awards of £1000 - £2000 to a total of £7000 through a bequest to UCL Medical School in 2014 in memory of Dr Norman Munro who graduated from UCH Medical School in 1953. Dr Munro was awarded a scholarship to study medicine at UCH Medical School in the 1940's, without which he would have been unable to pursue his chosen career.
