UCL Research Scholarships 24-25

- Two types of PhD scholarships offered by UCL each year in a college wide competition
 - 1. Research Excellence Scholarship (RES)
 - 2. China Scholarship Council-UCL Joint Research Scholarship (CSC)
- Each department can recommend two students
- Scholarships are highly competitive
- Main Criteria:
 - academic excellence
 - research experience
 - research plan and its impact on society



1. Research Excellence Scholarship (RES)

- Open to prospective and current UCL doctoral students of any country
- Covers full tuition fees (Home/OS)
- Covers maintenance stipend
- Includes research costs up to £1,200 per year
- Submission deadline for DoM is <u>5pm on Monday 4th December 2023</u>

2. China Scholarship Council - UCL Joint Research Scholarship (CSC)

- Funding offered by UCL and China Scholarships Council (CSC)
- Open to citizens and permanent residents of the People's Republic of China
- Full fees paid + living costs (check website for full details)
- Submission deadline for DoM is <u>5pm on Monday 4th December 2023</u>

3. Divisional Shortlisting Requirements

- Main Criteria academic excellence and research experience
- BSc students expected to be awarded a First-class honour (1:1)
- MSc students you were awarded a First-class BSc (1:1)
- MSc holders you were awarded a Master's with Distinction
- Application documents to be submitted by <u>5pm on Monday 4th</u>
 <u>December 2023</u>
- Scholarship applications must be made via the department in order to be considered



4. Submitting your scholarship application

- Please read the guidance provided on the websites in full
- Check whether you meet the eligibility criteria before applying
- Submit your scholarship application documents as follows:
 - Send all files <u>in one email</u> with the subject heading 'RES 24/25' to <u>med.postgrad-research@ucl.ac.uk</u> by <u>5pm on Monday 4th December 2023</u>.
 - If your references are to be sent separately, please ensure that the student's full name is included in the subject heading along with 'RES 24/25'
- Submit a UCL graduate application by 2nd Jan 2024 (Prospective students only)

The Division will only support and nominate two students, so there will be an internal shortlisting process to determine the Divisional nominees.

Scholarship applications must be made via the department in order to be considered.
