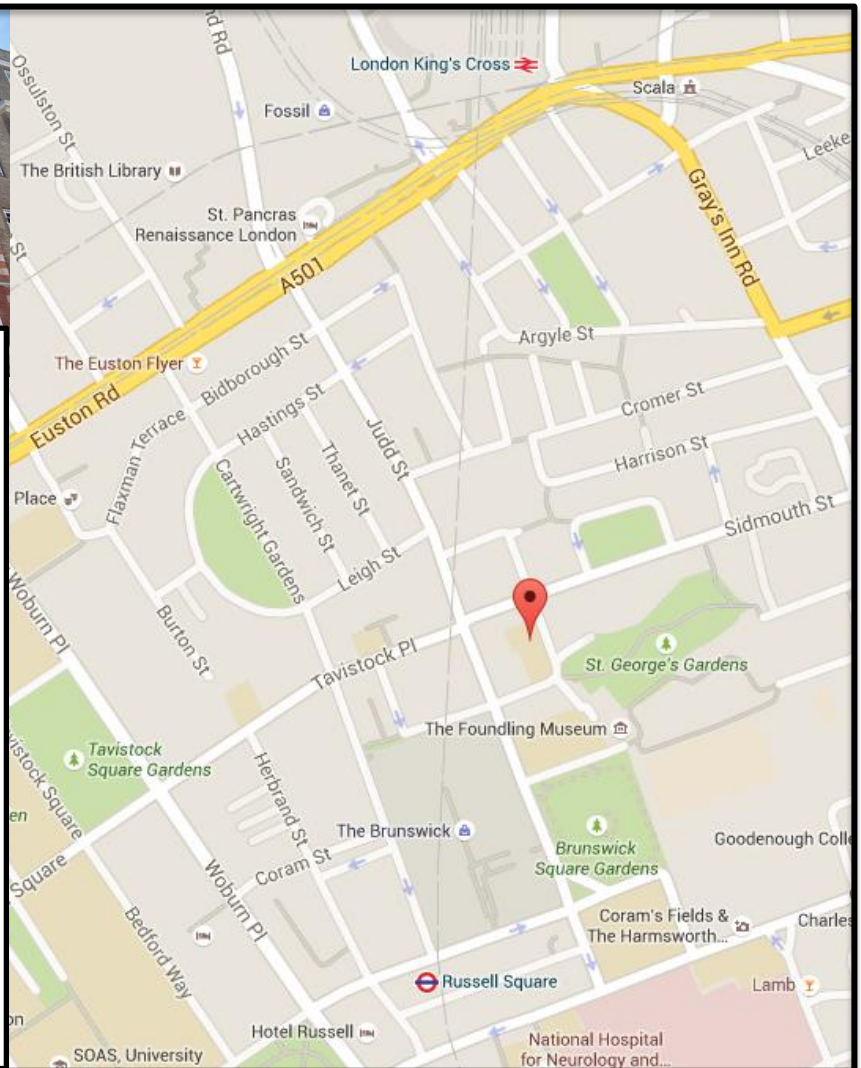

# Communication Clinic **RESEARCH REGISTER** INFORMATION SHEETS



University College London staff and students carry out **research** into communication difficulties.

These research projects often need **volunteers** to take part.

The Research Register is a list of people who would like to volunteer.

We use it to:

- let **volunteers know about projects** that are looking for people to take part
- let **researchers know about volunteers** who may be suitable for their projects.







**Each research project is different.** You will be **given more information** about a research project if you are suitable to take part.

If you agree to be added to the register, we will **keep** some information about you on a database. This will include your name, date of birth, contact details (address, phone number, email address etc.) and also information about the difficulties you have.

We will ask you if we can **share** information about your difficulties and test results from one project **with other projects**. This will help researchers find suitable volunteers more easily and may reduce the amount of testing you are asked to do.

We will ask you if you want us to **share** information about your difficulties and test results with **speech and language therapists or other healthcare professionals** that are working with you. This may help those professionals in their work with you and may reduce the amount of testing you are asked to do.

## Do I have to take part?





	<p><b>You can decide</b></p> <p>You <b>don't have to</b></p> <p>If you don't take part you will <b>still get your normal help</b></p>
 	<p>If you change your mind, <b>you can ask to have your details removed</b> from the register at any time</p> <p>You <b>don't</b> have to <b>give a reason</b></p> <p><b>If you stop</b> you will still get your <b>normal help</b></p>
  	<p>You don't have to decide now, you can <b>think about it</b></p> <p>You can <b>take your time</b></p> <p>You can <b>read</b> the information <b>again</b></p> <p>You can <b>talk to your family</b> to <b>help you decide</b></p>

## Who will see the information about me?

 	<p>We will keep the <b>information</b> about you <b>safe</b></p> <p>We <b>keep</b> the information until you <b>stop volunteering</b> for projects. Then we will <b>delete</b> it</p> <p>We will <b>not share</b> the information without your consent</p> <p>You can read the <b>Privacy notice</b> on our website</p> <p>(There is a link to UCL's full version there too)</p>

	<p>You may <b>enjoy</b> taking part</p>
	<p>You may find it <b>interesting</b></p>
	<p>You will help us to <b>learn</b></p> <p>You may <b>help</b> people in the <b>future</b></p>
 	<p>Some projects include <b>therapy</b> that may <b>help you</b>. The therapy <b>may not help</b> you. The research is to find out.</p> <p><b>You will be told if a project includes therapy or not.</b></p>
