The main duties of the post are supporting teaching, facilitating tutorial sessions and timely coursework / examination marking.

The successful candidates will be pursuing a postgraduate degree, preferably associated with The School of Sustainable Construction, or studying a related subject. Previous teaching experience is an advantage but is not essential.

The appointments will be made on grade 6, point 22, of the UCL salary scale, and PGTAs will normally be contracted for a maximum total of 180 hours of work over the academic year. PGTAs will be paid for attendance at training sessions, lectures, tutorial preparation and teaching time, plus marking (expected hours will be agreed in advance).

Application is via the brief application form (attached) and a brief academic CV.

Your CV should also detail your completed degrees, details of current employer, and details of previous employment.

The closing date for application is Friday 10 May 2024 (however late applications may be considered). It is expected that offers of PGTA appointments will begin to be made soon after the closing date. The panel may elect to interview shortlisted candidates via Teams or in person.
