Approach/Methods

- Video-based focus group
- Using maps (before-after) as a means to discuss changes
- Observation of events (meetings etc) as a data collection method
- Careful introduction of research

WMA sampling

- Mbarang'andu and Tundulu are quite similar
- Wami-Mbiki, Pawaga-Idodi,
- Ikona WMA not sampled – why?
 - High income, gazetted

Village sampling

- Non-WMA villages with and without wildlife related business activities
- Village sampling purposively; wildlife income, livelihood, conflicts, villages that have/have not contributed land etc.

Sample

- Ensure that different livelihood strategies (e.g. pastoralists vs. farmers) are represented in the WMA

Survey

- Have WMA boundaries been renegotiated?
- Do villages share resources during the dry season? Do people perceive resource pressure during dry season?
- Encroachment
- Relations with investors for WMA and non-WMA villagers?
- Modalities for revenue/benefit sharing
- Relation between WMA management and villages
