Highlights will include: The Rollright Stones, Crickley Hill, Stanton Harcourt and Wittenham Clumps/Dorchester, along with plenty of others along the way.

Day 2: The Cotswolds: (The Rollright Stones, Salmonsbury Camp and Crickley Hill).

Day 3: The Thames Valley (Stanton Harcourt, Wittenham Clumps and Dorchester-on-Thames).

Depart from Oxford Station c. 3pm.
