# Care experienced students

Care experienced applicants who are attending or have attended a UK state school, may be automatically eligible for the Access UCL scheme.

UCL defines care experienced as a person aged 25 or under who has been looked after by a local authority for at least three months in total. The months do not have to be consecutive.

There is a space on the UCAS application form for you to declare that you have spent time in care. We will contact any UCL applicant who has ticked this box to verify their status and consider them for the Access UCL scheme.

We will need to receive confirmation of your time in care from your local authority. Further details on this process will be sent to you when you apply to UCL. All information provided will be treated with the utmost confidence.

If you have spent time in care and you attended a UK independent or fee-paying school, please email **[wp.accessucl@ucl.ac.uk](mailto:wp.accessucl@ucl.ac.uk)** to check your eligibility, and we will assess your case on an individual basis.
