

Genetic Modification Safety Officer



- To provide technical¹ and administrative advice on the processes and procedures in place at UCL for work with genetically modified organisms.
- To provide regular updates (at least annually or more frequently if required) to their Head of Department on the genetic modification activities currently taking place within the Department.
- To be the point of contact between their Department, the UCL GMSC and the University Biological Safety Adviser for receiving and disseminating, to relevant members of the department, information on health and safety in relation to work with genetically-modified organisms.
- To provide input/assistance, as required, during inspection/auditing of Departmental work areas where GM activities are taking place.
- To receive such information, instruction and training to ensure that the above tasks are carried out competently.
