We want to let you know about some changes to the way UCL students select their modules.

How this affects you will depend on whether your programme offers a choice of modules. Please read the relevant section below depending on your programme.

## If your programme offers a choice of modules

On 4 April we will be asking you to select your preferred modules for the 2022/23 academic year.

Those of you that have been studying with us for two or more years will notice that we are asking you to select earlier this year. This is a direct result of your feedback.

We know that our students want to know what they will be studying earlier in the year. From now on, departments will be confirming your modules in July instead of September.

We want to help you get a place on the modules you most want to study. Places are not guaranteed. However, submitting your modules earlier, in April, will give you the best chance of getting a place on your preferred modules.

In some circumstances you may be able to change your module selections from mid-July. We will do our best to support students to make alternative selections where needed. However, changes are not guaranteed.

You will be able to visit the UCL Module Catalogue from 4 April to find out which modules are being offered for the 2022/23 academic year with details including descriptions and how the module will be assessed.

We'll be in touch again in April to let you know when you can begin selecting your preferred modules.
