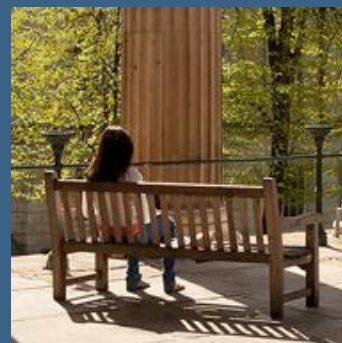

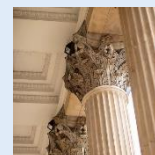
CPD opportunity to learn more about managing education quality at UCL
