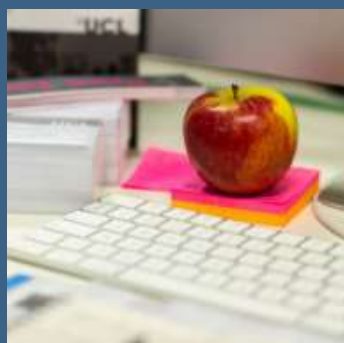

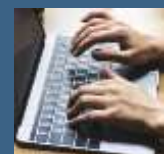
### Supported sessions for 2019/20 programme diets
