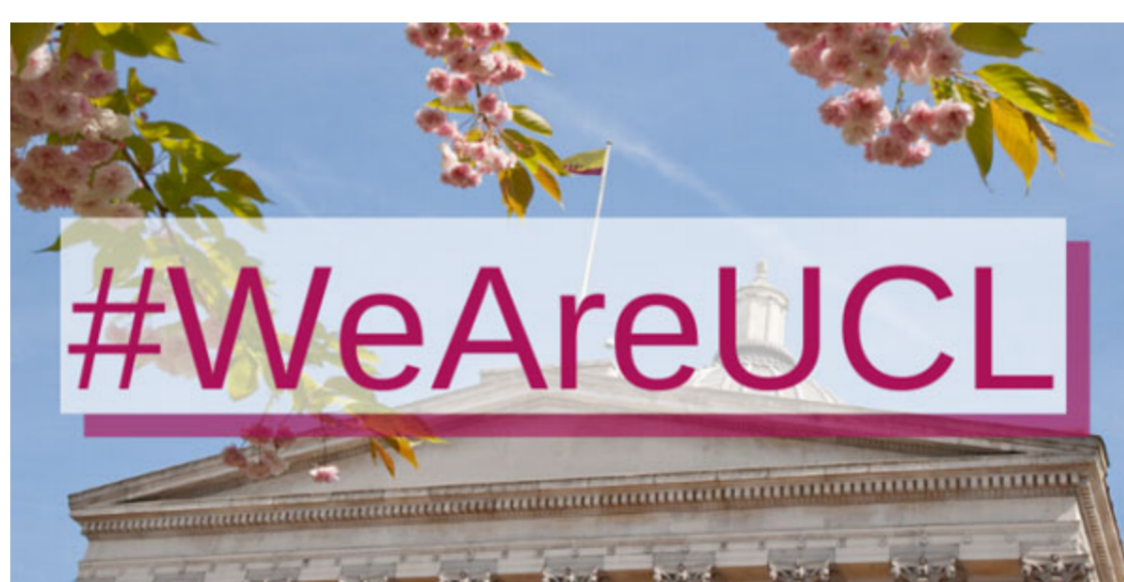

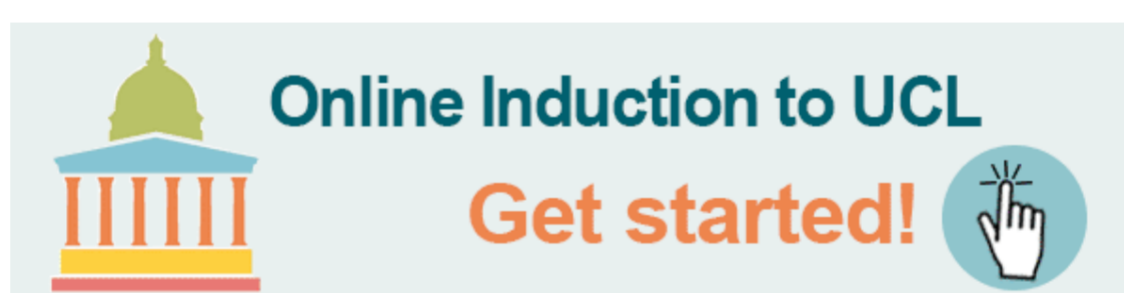
UCL Minds

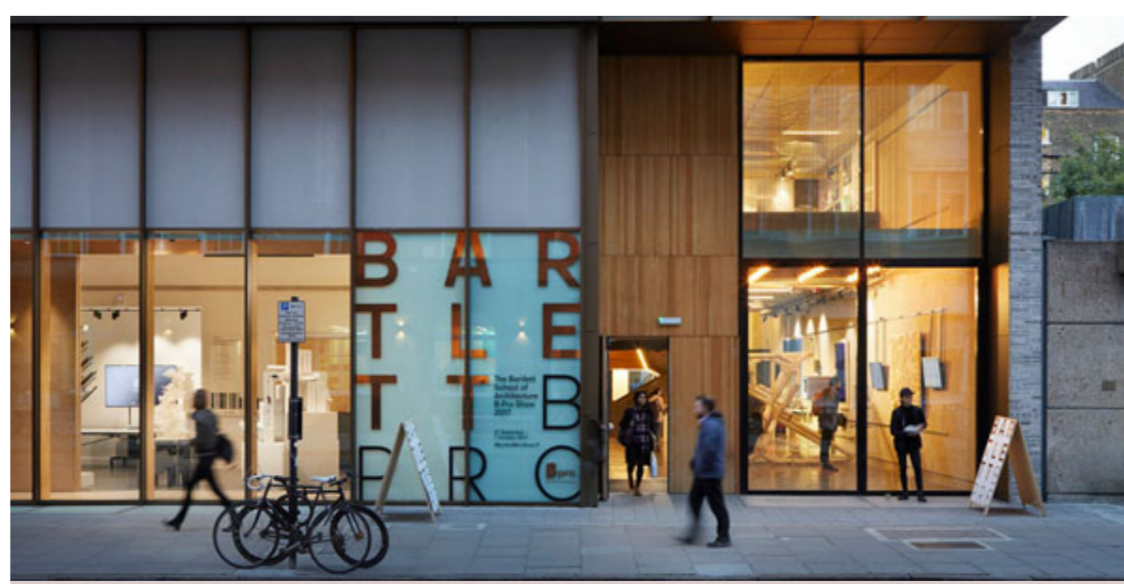
