Palestine advocacy and academic freedom are under attack on UK campuses. Some universities have banned Palestinian events. Others monitor the social media posts of staff and students. One has disinvited a distinguished visiting scholar (of Jewish origin) because of his criticisms of Israel. Another has cancelled a staff-student scholarly discussion about Palestine. Many invoke disciplinary processes in response to malicious complaints that conflate anti-Zionism with antisemitism. The silencing of Palestinian voices needs to be challenged on every university campus.
