The Slade School of Fine Art's Summer School, involves a variety of disciplines, including Drawing, Sculpture, Photography, Video, Painting, Performance and Contextual Studies. Each day you'll explore aspects of these disciplines and their interconnectedness, through practical independent work. This Summer School will enable you to gain some expert tuition in Art, and experience what it's like to make in an art studio environment.

Our aim is to give you an insight into the studio culture and tutorial approaches you might experience at degree level study in Fine Art. We also hope to instill confidence in working independently, outside of your normal learning environment. You will be encouraged to experiment, to extend your drawing and making skills and to engage in dialogue with peers and mentors about your work.

The fast-paced working day of activities will be supplemented by contextual studies through lectures, seminars and tutorials and opportunities to interact with peers attending other courses, Foundation Year students, Slade Undergraduate and Postgraduate students. There will be a Portfolio Review and Q&A session at the end of the week, as well as your own curated exhibition of the work produced followed by a private view. Additionally, there should be follow up support in the form of a portfolio guidance workshop later in the year.
